SELECTION CRITERIA

- The selection panel for all club teams should consist of three people, one will be the team coach, the others may be the coaching coordinator or members nominated by the club executive.
- The coaching co-coordinator may attend all selections.
- Senior players may not take part in the selection of teams they may be selected in.

Selections should take into account the following:-

- Attendance at training and games
- Attitude
- Skill level
- Fitness
- Availability for training and games
- Approach towards supporting other members of the team and understanding of team commitment.
- Performance at training and games
- Game play – understanding of the game
- Improvement
- Proven ability to further develop skills

Players who do not attend pre-season training or fitness without a legitimate reason will not be selected in the turf teams.

Players who do not train to the satisfaction of the coach will be replaced by a player from the division below who has been chosen by the team coach.

Players who are asked to “fill-in” in a higher division are not to displace a regular member of the higher team unless a player in the higher team is injured.

Players who will be absent for a length of time during the season, or who have other commitments that are likely to clash with SWU hockey training and games, should make the selectors aware of this at the start of the season, as upon their return will not necessarily assume a place in their previous position or team.

De- registration of Players

A coach may de-register a player to the team below if the player

- Does not perform to the standard required by the coach at training or during games
- Does not attend training or fitness.
- Is a disruption to the team

If the rules of BWA do not allow the automatic de-registration, the player will be side-lined at the coach's discretion.

These players must attend games but will not take the field.
